## Film Artist Shaune Harrison Opens U.K. Make-up School







The U.K.-based make-up effects artist Shaune Harrison-whose credits include the Harry Potter film series, Captain America: The First Avenger and World War Z-has decided to share what he's learned in the movie business over the last two decades.

So on May 12, he opened the doors to the new Shaune Harrison Makeup Academy in Manchester.

"The big difference with my school from others in the area is my expertise in prosthetic make-up artistry," Harrison explained. "I'm one of the only schools to solely concentrate on the art of prosthetic effects."

The academy will offer prosthetic and make-up courses for all skill levels, focusing on sculpting, painting and applying pieces.

"At the moment, I'll be teaching the main classes, as each class doesn't overlap, but as we get

busier in the coming months, I will be bringing in my industry friends and colleagues," he said. "We want to keep the classes to a maximum of eight students so they'll receive the best teaching from me and not get lost in the pack. I want to teach them the most up-to-date techniques available and hopefully become one of the industry's leading prosthetic teachers."

The next courses on offer are Casualty FX & Wounds (July 14-25) and Sculpting (July 28-Aug. 1).
